

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Wednesday – 17th June 2015

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1508 Cattle consisting of 825 Prime Cattle and 683 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 67 Bullocks, 85 Heifers, 645 Cows and 28 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of 241 Steers, 415 Heifers, and 27 Cows & Calves.

Cattle consisted of mostly several lines of well finished cows with few bullocks yarded. The balance of the yarding were of mixed condition showing the effects of the season. The yarding was drawn from Hughenden, Winton, Georgetown, Lakeland, Mt Garnet, Einasleigh, Forsayth, Belyando, Ingham, Home Hill, local and coastal areas. Bullocks were quoted 10-15¢ dearer, Heifers were 10-15¢ dearer and Cows 15¢ dearer than last week.
