

CHARTERS TOWERS STORE SALE **MARKET REPORT**

Friday 28th June 2013

Charters Towers combined agents yarded a total of **4148 Store Cattle**.

Consisting Of: 2416 Store Steers, 1365 Store Heifers, 168 Store Cows and 199 Cows and Calves

Cattle were drawn from Forsayth, Croydon, Cloncurry, Richmond, Hughenden, Torrens Creek, Einasleigh, Mt Garnet, Ingham, Local & Coastal areas.

The Store Cattle comprised of good lines of heavier Steers that sold to dearer rates while weaner Steers were cheaper and met with limited competition. 200 - 350kg Steers were cheaper than the last sale while 351 - 500kg Steers were dearer by up to 4¢/kg. All Heifers sold to limited competition with values down on the last Store Sale.
