

CHARTERS TOWERS PRIME AND STORE SALE MARKET REPORT

Wednesday – 19th June 2013

Charters Towers combined agents yarded a total of **891 Cattle**.
Consisting of **586 Prime Cattle** and **305 Store Cattle** at this week's Sale.

Prime Cattle Consisted Of: 122 Bullocks, 36 Heifers, 393 Cows and 35 Bulls.

Store Cattle Consisted Of: 109 Steers, 191 Heifers & 5 Cows & Calves.

Prime Cattle comprised of good finished lines to show slight improvement on last week's rates in the cows & bullocks. The yarding was drawn from Burketown, Greenvale, Hughenden, Cloncurry, local & coastal areas. Bullocks were quoted 3¢ dearer, Heifers were 7¢ easier and Cows were 3¢ dearer, on last week's rates.

- The top pen of Cows were sold A/c Trevor Mitchell for 117¢/kg to weigh 575kg and return \$668 per head.
- Bulls sold on A/c Nardoo Pastoral NQ, Cloncurry, topped at 114¢/kg and weighed 655kg to return \$746 per head.
