

CHARTERS TOWERS PRIME AND STORE SALE MARKET REPORT

Charters Towers combined agents yarded a total of 542 Cattle.

Consisting of 487 Prime Cattle and 55 Store Cattle at this week's Sale.

Prime Cattle Consisted Of: 239 Bullocks, 13 Heifers, 194 Cows and 41 Bulls.

Store Cattle Consisted Of: 35 Steers and 20 Heifers.

Cattle comprised of good lines of finished Meatworks Bullocks backed up by good lines of finished Meatworks Cows. The yarding was drawn from Georgetown, Mt Surprise, Cloncurry, Pentland, Collinsville, Townsville, Local & Coastal areas. Bullocks were 10-12¢ dearer, Heifers were 7-8¢ dearer, Cows sold to similar rates and Bulls were the same as last week's rates.
