

**CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE**

**Wednesday – 16<sup>th</sup> September 2015**

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1488 Cattle consisting of 942 Prime Cattle and 546 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 116 Bullocks, 14 Heifers, 750 Cows and 62 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of 332 Steers, 197 Heifers, 0 Cows and 17 Cows & Calves.

Cattle consisted of a few larger lines of good quality cows, with smaller lines of steers & bulls. The yarding was drawn from Burketown, Normanton, Richmond, Julia Creek, Woodstock & local surrounds with Bullocks 15¢ dearer, Heifers 5¢ easier and Cows 10¢ dearer than last week.
