

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Friday – 21st November 2014

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 954 Cattle consisting of 306 Prime Cattle and 648 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 107 Bullocks, 20 Heifers, 122 Cows and 57 Bulls. Store Cattle yarded: 321 Steers, 306 Heifers and 21 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of few finished bullocks and cows. Limited meatworks buyers were in attendance due to current seasonal conditions and hence supply available. The yarding was drawn from Ingham, Pentland, Gumlu, local and coastal areas. Bullocks were quoted 10-15c easier, Heifers were unchanged and Cows were 10-15c easier on last sale's rates.

- Bullocks topped at 175c/kg, sold on a/c R.P. Bacchiella, Ingham, that weighed 780kg to return \$1365 per head.
- Best priced Trade Heifers were presented on a/c Warrawee Pastoral Co which made 156.2c/kg to weigh 420kg and return \$656 per head.
- The top pen of Cows were sold by L.B. Amos, Noorlah Road, Charters Towers, for 135c/kg and weighed 476kg to return \$643 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c M & A Slaughter, Springsure, topped at 1.40c/kg and weighed 540kg to return \$756 per head.

Store Quotes:

Store cattle were showing all the signs of the now trying season. There were a few lines of steers and heifers which were met with reasonable competition along with the better types. Young and small types however were met with less competition.
