

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded 2951 Cattle consisting of 1032 Prime Cattle and 1919 Store Cattle.

Prime Cattle: 150 Bullocks, 25 Heifers, 742 Cows and 85 Bulls.

Store Cattle: 994 Steers, 802 Heifers and 123 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of small lines of Bullocks with a large percentage of fair conditioned cows. The yarding was drawn from Chillagoe, Prairie, Richmond, Woodstock, Belyando, local & coastal areas. Bullocks were quoted 10 cents easier, Heifers were 10 cents easier and Cows were 10 cents easier on last sale's rates.
