

<u>CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE</u> Wednesday – 26th August 2015

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2030 Cattle, consisting of 1086 Prime Cattle and 944 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 134 Bullocks, 65 Heifers, 800 Cows and 87 Bulls. Store Cattle yarded: 504 Steers, 433 Heifers and 10 Cows & Calves.

Cattle consisted of smaller runs of finished bullocks, with the majority of the Prime section consisting of larger runs of covered and plainer cows. The yarding was drawn from Normanton, Burketown, Hughenden, Richmond, Mt Surprise, Coastal and local areas. Bullocks were 5 – 6c easier, Heifers 5c dearer, and Cows unchanged on last week's rates.

- Bullocks topped at 258¢/kg a pen of Brahman cross sold on A/c EJT & K Camp, "Floraville" Burketown, weighing in at 560kg to return \$1447/hd.
- A single bullock sold on A/c Harold Green Woodstock made \$246c, for 760kg and \$1871.
- Top priced Trade Heifers were presented on a/c S & K Wheeler, Charters Towers making 236¢/kg to weigh 474kg and return \$1119/hd.
- The top pen of Cows were sold by Koolyn Pty Ltd, Charters Towers for 242c/kg, and weighed 490kg to return \$1186/hd.
- Bulls topped at 265c/kg for Dept Ag & Fisheries, weighing 870kg and returning \$2307/hd.

Store Quotes:

Store cattle were several lines of good quality, with some lighter runs showing the effects of the season, and some mixed quality types also coming forward. A small gallery of buyers competed for the cattle on offer, with sale results and averages improving across the board.

- A good pen of Brahman heifers A/c D & S Hartwell, Nevada Stn Guthalungra topped the sale at 219c/kg, weighed 185kg and returned \$405/hd.
- A pen of crossbred heifers sold on A/c Bluegrass Cattle Co, Amarra Station Charters Towers made 206c/kg, weighing 319kg and returning \$658/hd
- Several smaller lines of Cows and Calves sold in a range from \$780 to \$930 per unit.
