

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE Wednesday – 29th July 2015

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1049 Cattle consisting of 342 Prime Cattle and 707 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 44 Bullocks, 29 Heifers, 262 Cows and 7 Bulls. Store Cattle yarded: 327 Steers, 367 Heifers and 13 Cows & Calves.

Prime Cattle consisted of very mixed lines of quality with more plainer types yarded this week than last week's sale. Limited Bullocks to quote with mostly Cows yarded. The yarding was drawn from Ingham, Mt Fox, Trebonne, Ayr, Cromarty, Giru, Alligator Creek, Einasleigh, Forsayth, Georgetown, Mt Surprise, Richmond, Stamford, Hughenden and local areas. Bullocks were unchanged, Heifers unchanged and Cows 2.4¢ dearer than last week.

There were good quality lines of Store Cattle yarded with Brahman Weaner Steers and Brangus Weaner Steers selling to 240.2¢/kg and No.3 & 4 mixed coloured Brahman Heifers selling to 207.2. Competition was firm and consistent on all the Store Cattle especially full pens of quality Heifers.
