

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE Wednesday – 30th September, 2015

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1987 Head. Cattle consisting of 730 Prime Cattle and 1257 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 255 Bullocks, 10 Heifers, 335 Cows and 130 Bulls. Store Cattle yarded 674 Steers, 519 Heifers and 64 Cows & Calves.

Cattle consisted of a small selection of finished Bullocks and Cows with the remainder of the yarding plainer condition, along with runs of northern cleanskins and lesser quality cattle. The Yarding was drawn from Normanton, Hughenden, Georgetown, Ingham, Burdekin, Coastal and Local areas. Bullocks were 2-5 cents dearer, Heifers N/A, Cows unchanged on last week's rates.

 per head.
- Top priced Trade Heifers were presented on a/c Messmate Past Co, Ingham, making 218.2¢/kg to weigh 330kg and return \$654 per head.
- The top pen of Cows were sold by G & D Donovan, Woodstock for 250.2¢/kg and weighed 560kg to return \$1401 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c Bellgrove Grazing Co, Alice River topped at 270.2¢/kg, 870kg and made \$2350 per head.

Store Cattle were made up of smaller pens of good quality steers, with the bulk of the yarding comprising lines of Northern Cleanskins and plainer types. The exception was several lines of good quality backgrounder heifers.
