

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE Wednesday – 6th September 2017

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1483 Cattle consisting of 488 Prime Cattle and 995 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 141 Bullocks, 18 Heifers, 249 Cows and 80 Bulls. Store Cattle yarded 780 Steers, 195 Heifers, 0 Cows and 20 Cows & Calves.

Prime Cattle comprised of a lesser quality yarding with fewer good finished Bullocks presented and only pockets of well finished Cows yarded. The yarding was drawn from Normanton, Croydon, Georgetown, Mt Surprise, Malanda, Einasleigh, Kidston, Hughenden, Torrens Creek, Greenvale, local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes:

Bullocks were quoted 2-4¢ dearer, Heifers were 1-3¢ easier, and Cows under 400kg were 2-6¢ easier on last week's rates, while heavy Cows over 400kg were 2-4¢ dearer. Bulls over 400kg sold to cheaper rates of 4-6¢ selling to 239.2¢/kg to average 230¢/kg.

- Bulls sold on A/c Lawrie Grazing Trust, "Powlathanga Station", Balfes Creek, topped at 237.2¢/kg and weighed 731kg to return \$1734 per head.

Store Quotes:

622 Weaner Bulls from mostly 3 properties in North Queensland dominated the 995 Feeder Cattle yarded. Mostly in the 200kg to 320kg range, the Weaner Bulls sold to a top of 338.2¢/kg to average 299¢/kg.
