

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Wednesday – 7th June 2017

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1592 Cattle consisting of 738 Prime Cattle and 854 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 73 Bullocks, 17 Heifers, 582 Cows and 66 Bulls. Store Cattle yarded consisted of: 413 Steers, 407 Heifers, 34 x 34 Cows & Calves.

Prime Cattle comprised of mostly mixed lines of local cattle supported by drafts from Normanton and Hughenden. The condition of the yarding was good with only a small percentage showing signs of the colder weather. Bullocks were quoted 8-12¢ dearer, Heifers were unchanged and cows were unchanged on last week's rates.

- The top pen of Cows were sold by BB and DA Von Wald, for 226.2¢/kg and weighed 516kg to return \$1168 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c D Jackson and Sons topped at 280.2¢/kg and weighed 800kg to return \$2241 per head.
