

SPECIAL STORE SALE CHARTERS TOWERS **MARKET REPORT**

Friday 5th July 2013

3793 Store Cattle were yarded at the Special Store Sale in Charters Towers.

Consisting Of: 3078 Store Steers, 660 Store Heifers, 19 Store Cows and 36 Cows and Calves

Cattle were drawn from Burketown, Georgetown, Cloncurry, Richmond, Hughenden, Mingela, Ingham, and the Charters Towers district.

A gallery of Store buyers saw values of Steers especially in the 200 – 320kg range increase to rates of 177.2¢/kg with Bigger Steers in the 320 – 500kg range selling on firm rates to the previous sale. Heifers up to 200kg were 3¢/kg dearer while bigger Heifers sold to similar rates. The best of the Heifers sold to 134.2¢/kg.
