

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE
Wednesday – 9th May 2018

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 943 hd.

Cattle consisting of 552 Prime Cattle and 391 Store Cattle.

The Prime Cattle consisted of 98 Bullocks, 52 Heifers, 326 Cows and 76 Bulls.

Store Cattle consisted of 136 Steers, 194 Heifers and 61 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of fewer lines of good Bullocks, a run of good heavy Cows with a few lesser Northern Cows. The yarding was drawn from Forsayth, Chillagoe, Mt Garnet, Bowen, local and coastal areas. Bullocks were quoted 5¢ easier, Heifers were 10¢ dearer, Cows were 10¢ dearer & Bulls were 5¢ easier, on last week's rates.
