

## CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE Wednesday – 27<sup>th</sup> June 2018

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2051 Cattle consisting of 892 Prime Cattle and 1159 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 120 Bullocks, 27 Heifers, 677 Cows and 74 Bulls. Store Cattle yarded consisted of: 867 Steers, 276 Heifers, 1 Cow and 16 Cows & Calves.

Prime Cattle comprised of mostly meat works Cows yarded with only small lines of Bullocks and Prime Heifers and Bulls. The yarding was drawn from Mt Isa, Normanton, Julia Creek, Richmond, Einasleigh, Georgetown, Tully, Ingham, Collinsville and local areas. Bullocks were quoted 1-6¢ easier, Heifers were 2-8¢ dearer, Cows were 2-3¢ dearer and Heavier Bulls were 3-5¢ easier on last week's rates.

- Best priced Trade Heifers were presented on a/c MGS Pastoral, "Junction Creek", Greenvale that sold for 220.2¢/kg and weighed 415kg to return \$913 per head.
- The top pen of Cows was for 16 Brahman Cows sold by Fanning Downs Partnership, Macrossan for 196.2¢/kg, weighing 551kg to return \$1080 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c DJ & SJ Beauchamp, "Allendale Station", Ingham, topped at 270.2¢/kg and weighed 754kg to return \$2037 per head.

## **Store Quotes:**

The 1159 Store Cattle generally were slightly easier while the large line of young weaner type males met with good competition selling to 2-3¢ better on last week's rates. The Store Cattle yarded today consisted of 80% Steers and approx. 20% heifers and a handful of Cows & Calves. There were two large consignments of Store Cattle from Ingham and Normanton that dominated the yarding.
