

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Wednesday - 3rd October 2018

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1485 Cattle consisting of 929 Prime Cattle and 566 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 129 Bullocks, 71 Heifers, 634 Cows and 95 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of 176 Steers, 360 Heifers, 20 Cows and 19 Calves.

Cattle comprised of limited No's of plainer Bullocks with lines of Cows and Bulls from North and North West. The yarding was drawn from Mt Isa, Burketown, Normanton, Forsayth, local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes:

Bullocks were quoted as Unchanged, Heifers were 8 - 12¢ dearer, Cows were 2 - 7¢ dearer and Bulls were Unchanged on last week's rates.

- Bullocks topped at 265¢/kg for 3 Bullocks Sold on A/C Pedracini Grazing, "Scartwater", Charters Towers that weighed 523kg to return \$1387 per head.
- Best priced Trade Heifers were presented on a/c AJ and MA Spurdle, Mingela that sold 244¢/kg to weigh 437kg and return \$1068 per head.
- The top pen of Cows were sold by PB and SE Curley, Charters Towers, for 229¢/kg and weighed 702kg to return \$1608 per head.
- Bulls sold on account Pemble Invest, Balfes Creek topped at 247¢/kg weighed 638kg to return \$1577.

Store Quotes:

Store cattle are all showing the effects of the prolonged dry season. A smaller number of Steers lacked quality and were priced accordingly. Heifers were of average quality and prices were up 10 - 12¢.
