

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1808 head. Consisting of 819 Prime Cattle and 898 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 116 Bullocks, 14 Heifers, 596 Cows and 93 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of 226 Steers, 541 Heifers, 219 Mickeys and 3 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of large consignment of Cows with a few Bullocks and Bulls. The yarding was drawn from Croydon, Richmond, Belyando, Collinsville, the Gulf, Coastal and Local areas.
