

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE **Wednesday – 15th May 2019**

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1,709 head.
Cattle consisted of 922 Prime Cattle and 787 Store Cattle.
The Prime Cattle consisted of 132 Bullocks, 79 Heifers, 604 Cows and 107 Bulls.
Store Cattle consisted of 425 Steers, 207 Heifers and 155 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of smaller runs of well finished Prime Cattle with a fair yarding of just off the pace Cows. The yarding was drawn from Georgetown, Greenvale, Hughenden, Tully, local and coastal areas.

Heavy Bullocks were quoted as 15¢ dearer, Heifers were 20¢ easier, Cows were 20¢ easier and Bulls were 10¢ dearer compared to last week's rates.
