

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE **Wednesday – 11th March 2020**

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1232 cattle, consisting of 468 Prime Cattle and 764 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 79 Bullocks, 78 Heifers, 275 Cows and 31 Bulls.
Store Cattle consisted of 485 Steers, 282 Heifers and 11 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of large runs of Store Steers & Heifers with limited numbers of prime cattle. The yarding was drawn from Hughenden, Einasleigh, Georgetown, Tully, Torrens Creek, Mt Surprise, Bowen, Pentland, local & coastal areas. Bullocks were quoted 5-7c dearer, Heifers were 12-68c dearer, Cows 10-12c dearer and Bulls 5-10c dearer.

- The top pen of Cows was sold by JH & TA Lindsay, "Landsborough Downs", Hughenden for 294.2c/kg, weighing 484kg to return \$1423 per head.
- Bulls sold on A/c MV Caspani, Ravenswood topped at 364.2c/kg to return \$2160 per head.

Store Quotes:

Store cattle attracted strong competition with two backgrounders and one exporter competing well on steers, especially the Brahman types.
