

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS STORE SALE

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 3,577 head.
Store Cattle consisted of 1,598 Steers, 246 Mickeys, 1,696 Heifers and 37 Cows & Calves.

Cattle were drawn from a wide area this week, coming from Mt Isa, Burketown, Normanton, Richmond, Hughenden, as well as local and coastal areas.

Store cattle consisted of smaller lines of both Steers and Heifers with the quality of the yarding improved on previous weeks. Steers sold to similar rates to last week, with Heifers quoted 10-15¢ dearer.
