

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE **Wednesday – 28th April 2021**

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2204 cattle, consisting of 1090 Prime Cattle and 1114 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 143 Bullocks, 142 Heifers, 618 Cows and 187 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of 344 Steers, 498 Heifers, 84 Cows and Calves & 188 Mickey Bulls.

Cattle comprised of very good lines of fat Cows, few finished Ox & Heifers and large numbers of fat Bulls. The yarding was drawn from Richmond, Normanton, Mt Isa, Hughenden, Greenvale, as well as local & coastal areas.

Bullocks were quoted 6¢ dearer, Heifers were 8¢ dearer, Cows were 10¢ dearer & Bulls 8¢ dearer on last week's rates.
