Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 3,633 cattle.
Store Cattle consisted of 1,696 Steers, 620 Mickeys, 1,299 Heifers and 18 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of predominantly good lines of quality Brahman and Cross Bred Steers & Heifers, selling to high prices not seen in Charters Towers before.

The yarding was drawn from Winton, Richmond, Hughenden, Georgetown, Forsayth, Mt Surprise, Mt Garnet, Mt Isa, Bowen, as well as local and coastal areas.
