

**CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS STORE SALE**  
**Friday – 20<sup>th</sup> August 2021**

**Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 3381 Store Cattle. The Cattle consisted of 1774 Steers, 1262 Heifers, 10 Cows, 23 Cows & Calves and 312 Mickeys.**

An exceptional yarding of quality cattle that were made up of bigger runs of Steers and some smaller runs of Heifers that were drafted well and met with strong competition on all descriptions. Majority of the yarding were mostly larger Feeder types over 300kg with fewer Weaner cattle yarded this week. Crossbred cattle met with the strongest demand and sold to dearer rates while Brahman and Brahman Cross cattle met with good competition selling to similar rates as the previous sale.

The yarding was drawn from Burketown, Normanton, Georgetown, Einasleigh, Cloncurry, Muttaburra, Pentland, Lakeland, Malanda, Innisfail, Japoonvale, Tully, Ingham, Proserpine, Bowen, Collinsville, Ayr, Clare, Ravenswood as well as local and coastal areas.

- A line of 583 Brahman Heifers a/c Morr Morr Pastoral Co, “Delta Downs”, Normanton topped at 464.2¢/kg to average 382.5¢/kg to weigh 236kg and return \$902 per head.
- 18 x 18 Cows & Calves sold on a/c LT & CP Curley, “Sutherland Holding”, Georgetown, returned \$2,280 per unit.
