

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME SALE Wednesday – 29th September 2021

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1,908 cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 592 Bullocks, 302 Heifers, 634 Cows and 380 Bulls.

Cattle comprised of fewer finished bullocks and cows which sold to strong rates, whilst the remainder of the cattle consisted of Northern bulls and cows. The yarding was drawn from Cloncurry, Normanton, Karumba, Richmond, Georgetown, as well as local and coastal areas.

<u>Prime Quotes:</u> Bullocks were quoted 5-8¢ dearer, Heifers were unchanged, Cows were 2-5¢ easier, and Bulls were 5-8¢ dearer on last week's rates.

- Best Priced trade Heifers were presented on a/c AB & PS Stanford, Upper Stone that sold for 390¢/kg, weighing 570kg to return \$2,223 per head.
- The top pen of cows were sold by Philipson Holdings, for 350¢/kg, weighing 536kg to return \$1,876 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c G & D Gordon, topped at 338¢/kg and weighed 760kg, to return \$2,569 per head.
