

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Wednesday – 13th April 2022

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 3,166 cattle, consisting of 1,639 Prime Cattle and 1,527 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 137 Bullocks, 240 Heifers, 945 Cows and 317 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of Steers, 560 Heifers and 7 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of larger runs of finished Cows, with limited Bullocks, Heifers and Bulls on offer. The yarding was drawn from Georgetown, Hughenden, Julia Creek, as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes: Bullocks were quoted 10-15¢ easier, Heifers were 15¢ easier, Cows were 5¢ easier, and Bulls were 5-10¢ dearer on last week's rates.

- Bullocks topped at 384.2¢/kg on a/c Philipson Holdings that weighed 745kg to return \$2,862 per head.
- Best Priced trade Heifers were presented on a/c G & K Forster that sold for 394.2¢/kg, weighing 480kg to return \$1,892 per head.
- The top pen of Cows were sold by Felspar Grazing Co, "Felspar", Charters Towers for 307.2¢/kg, weighing 584kg to return \$1,793 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c G & K Forster, topped at 314.2¢/kg and weighed 737kg, to return \$2,315 per head.

Store Quotes: Store cattle were comprised of larger runs of quality feeder Steers and lighter Steers that held a steady market. Heifers also had some larger runs, which held up in the heavier article but saw lighter Heifers reduce back.
