

## CHARTERS TOWERS STORE SALE MARKET REPORT

Charters Towers combined agents yarded a total of **2392 Store Cattle**.

**Consisting Of:** 1407 Steers, 929 Heifers, 38 Cows and 18 Cows and Calves

The Store Cattle comprised of good lines of quality Steers and Heifers from purebred Grey Brahms to straight Black Angus Cattle yarded with this sale comprising of mainly No. 2 and 3 young Cattle with very few No. 1 and older presented. Good buyer representation from Coastal areas from Tully to Mackay and central Queensland saw prices firm on the last sale with Steers selling to 156.2¢/kg and Heifers selling to 161.2¢/kg.

Cattle were drawn from the Belyando, Mt Surprise, Forsayth, Einasleigh, Georgetown, Croydon, Torrens Creek, Richmond, Ravenswood, Local and Coastal areas.
