

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE

Wednesday – 15th July, 2015

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2287.
 Cattle consisting of 1075 Prime Cattle and 1212 Store Cattle.

The Prime Cattle consisted of 128 Bullocks, 18 Heifers, 893 Cows and 36 Bulls.

Store Cattle consisted of 435 Steers and 777 Heifers.

Cattle consisted of small lines of finished Bullocks backed up by good lines of Cows that met good competition. The yarding was drawn from Georgetown, Einasleigh, Torrens Creek, Hughenden, Richmond, Woodstock, Mt. Garnet, local and coastal areas. Bullocks were quoted 5¢ easier, Heifers 10¢ easier and Cows were 2¢ easier than last week.

- Bulls sold on a/c Hughenden Hardware topped at 183.2¢/kg and weighed 550kg to return \$1007 per head.

Store Cattle were well represented with quality lines of Steers (435) and Heifers (777). The market was strong with limited Buyers bidding to a competitive market.
