GEANEY'S SPECIAL STORE SALE

Friday 6th July, 2012

Geaney's Pty Ltd Charters Towers yarded a total of 3151 **Cattle** at a Special Store Sale conducted in Charters Towers on Friday 6th July 2012

Consisting of 2258 Steers, 758 Heifers, 16 Cows, 56 Cows and Calves and 63 Mickies.

Cattle comprised of very good lines of quality cattle mixed with plainer types of smaller lines.

The yarding was drawn from "Calvert Hills" in the Northern Territory, Mt Surprise, Forsayth, Georgetown, Einasleigh, Ravenswood, Balfes Creek, Belyando, Mingela, Townsville, Local and Coastal areas.

Good quality Store Cattle sold to good rates with the best of the Steers selling to 220.2¢/kg, Heifers sold to 181.2¢/kg, Cows & Calves sold to \$700. Plainer quality types sold to very solid rates from the last sale. Heifers 200-300kg also sold to dearer rates while quality weaner steers & weaner heifers continued to meet with strong competition selling to a broad spectrum and enthusiastic gallery of buyers.
