

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE Wednesday – 2nd October 2019

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1,908 head.
Cattle consisted of 1,283 Prime Cattle and 625 Store Cattle.
The Prime Cattle consisted of 180 Bullocks, 79 Heifers, 442 Cows and 582 Bulls.
Store Cattle consisted of 267 Steers and 358 Heifers.

Cattle comprised of good pens of Fat Cattle that sold to higher demand with re-stockers operating on the lighter Cattle. The yarding was drawn from Georgetown, Mt Surprise, Richmond, Ingham, Belyando, as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes:

Heavy Bullocks were 6¢ easier, Heifers were 11¢ dearer, Cows were 5¢ easier, and Bulls were 15¢ dearer compared to last week's rates.
