

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE **Wednesday – 24th March 2021**

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2498 cattle, consisting of 1059 Prime Cattle and 1439 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 56 Bullocks, 279 Heifers, 651 Cows and 73 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of 658 Steers, 71 Mickey Bulls, 680 Heifers, and 30 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of large lines of good Cows & Heifers with a few Bullocks. The yarding was drawn from Georgetown, Mt Isa, Collinsville, Belyando, Julia Creek, Hughenden, Coastal & Local areas. Bullocks were quoted 5c dearer, Heifers were 10c dearer, Cows were 10c dearer, while Bulls remained strong and unchanged.
