

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE **Wednesday – 7th April 2021**

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1446 cattle, consisting of 847 Prime Cattle and 570 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 82 Bullocks, 59 Heifers, 585 Cows and 121 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of Steers 274, 296 Heifers.

Cattle comprised of strong lines of fat Cows & Bullocks, with a small yarding of fat Heifers & Bulls. The yarding was drawn from the Mt Garnet, Toonpan, Hughenden and the Belyando, local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes: Bullocks were quoted 20¢ dearer, Heifers were 30¢ dearer, Cows were 10¢ dearer, and Bulls were 10¢ easier on last week's rates.

- Best Priced trade Heifers were presented on A/c GA & WL Collins that sold for 348.2¢/kg, weighing 440kg to return \$1,532 per head.
- The top pen of cows were sold by DM & KF Luke for 280.2¢/kg, weighing 588kg to return \$1,646 per head.
- Bulls sold on A/c Loudon Bros Pty Ltd, "Eveleigh Station", Mt Surprise, topped at 328.2¢/kg and weighed 713kg, to return \$2,341 per head.

Store cattle were in good condition, with the steers being unchanged from last's week's rates whereas the heifers sold to a dearer trend.
